On your child's annual well visit, the healthcare providers at Cape Cod Pediatrics highly recommend the following tests to help detect any hearing or vision abnormalities. This is a proactive and preventative part of your child's yearly well exam.

The tests listed below are followed by their corresponding CPT Codes and informational links. We have listed the CPT Codes for your health insurance purposes. Please verify any out-of-pocket expenses with your primary insurance carrier by calling PRIOR to your scheduled appointment. We suggest you give them the information we have provided and ask what your patient responsibility would be; if any (this would include copay, deductible and or co-insurance). For your records, please note the representative's name and corresponding reference number for the telephone call.

Eroscan: (CPT Code 92587) \$95.00

Eroscan Test is part of the annual well child visit starting at 6 months.

Eroscan is a hearing screen for pediatric patients. It is a quick, objective inner ear assessment that identifies hearing loss and middle ear disorders. It is a useful tool in ruling out hearing loss as a contributing factor in speech and language delay or any other condition.

Diopsys: (CPT Code 95930) \$310.00

Diopsys Test is part of the annual well child visit starting at 6 months through age 10.

Diopsys vision exam helps detect treatable eye problems in infancy and childhood, allowing early referrals to ophthalmologists for treatment and better outcomes for children. The American Academy of Pediatrics have issued policy statements recommending that vision screening start as early as 6 months of age.

Spot Vision: (CPT Code 99174) \$45.00

Spot Vision is recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics for early detection of risk factors for amblyopia and other vision abnormalities.
