If you have a newborn, congratulations on the birth of your baby! If you are transferring your child(ren) from another practice, welcome! We pledge to provide the highest level of care for your family and look forward to caring for them as they grow into toddlers, young children, adolescents, and young adults.

We are a group practice with MD's and Nurse Practitioners who work in collaboration to provide the highest level of care to our patients. We will try our best to accommodate your request to schedule Well Child Visits or any appointment with specific concerns, with the provider of your choice. Same day sick visits, however, will be scheduled according to availability on that day. Please call 508-477-5306 to schedule an appointment.

We are open:

- Monday–Thursday from 8 a.m.–6 p.m.,
- Fridays from 8 a.m.–5 p.m.

For your convenience, we offer a Walk-in Clinic:

- Monday–Friday from 8–9 a.m.
- Monday–Thursday from 4–6 p.m.
- Friday evening from 4–5 p.m.

No appointment necessary, this is a first come, first served basis.

Please note, the Walk-in Clinic is strictly for acute illnesses such as cough, fever less than five days, pink eye, etc. It is not intended for on-going or more complex medical issues such as concussions, abdominal pain, chest pain, etc.

Your child(ren) will be scheduled for routine well visits determined by their age. We will see them frequently through age three, and annually after that.

Please note that we are a practice that firmly believes in the benefits of immunizations and full participation in our vaccine schedule is required by all. Cape Cod Pediatrics no longer accepts children into the practice if their parents choose not to immunize according to the recommended CDC guidelines.

We recognize that appointments sometimes need to be rescheduled. We do require a 24-hour notice of cancellation in order to avoid the \$35 no show/late cancellation fee. Our phones are on from 8 a.m.–4:30 p.m., Monday–Friday. If you call outside these hours to cancel your appointment, please leave a message with the answering service, it will time-stamp your call and we'll receive the message at 8 a.m. the next business day.

We take most commercial insurances, if you have an HMO plan, please list one of our MD's as the Primary Care Physician. If you have MassHealth, please be sure to enroll your child in the WellSense Boston Children's ACO package. We do ask parents of newborns to try to have your child enrolled and active by 30 days of life.

Co-pays are due at time of service, as are balances on your account.

If you are a divorced parent bringing your child in for treatment, you are responsible for payment. Any legal agreements regarding financial responsibilities should be worked between the parents.
